Worlingham CEVC Primary School

We have had a wonderful term here at Worlingham CEVC Primary School. Children being able to mix again, to sing during 'in person' assemblies and to take part in enrichment and extracurricular activities has been incredibly valuable and rewarding for them. This term the children have taken part in sports competitions, have worked with Snape Maltings for some excellent music sessions, our older children

have been able to swim once again, and Reverend Rich and the Open the Book Team from the diocese have been able to deliver assemblies for our children once again.

That is not to say that we have been unaffected by the ongoing pandemic - at the time of writing we have had to re-bubble a class, and have had to follow the guidance from Suffolk Public Health which has seen a reintroduction of staff wearing face masks in central areas and a restriction of the visitors we are able to have in school. We are currently a little uncertain how this will affect our Christmas productions, but we are planning to still have them even if the audiences will be just the staff and children in the school.

This year we have launched our reviewed curriculum and new'school vision' which has identified the key values of 'Community', 'Responsibility', 'Endeavour', 'Confidence', 'Curiosity' and 'Grace' we hold as a school and an unerring ambition for all children to have 'Massive Minds, Huge Hearts, Guided by God'. North Cove Nature Reserve

Cutting and clearing the wildflower meadow is always a major job at North Cove nature reserve. It is important that hay is cleared as leaving it would effectively fertilise the soil, which is not good for the wild flowers we wish to encourage.

Thus towards the end of August and throughout September, the volunteers were kept busy haymaking with much of the work done with traditional scythes - so much more user-friendly than using noisy

mowers. Two of our guys attended a scything course so that they could impart the info gained to other members of the team. Several areas in the meadow were left uncut to increase diversity of the plantlife.

We then moved onto the far meadow with considerable help from the landowner, Ben, and his Man Friday Sean along with his small tractor, which made life easier. We now have many good piles of hay which we'll put on the paths to make a more pleasurable walk for the visitors.

The work is all carried out by volunteers from what was Beccles Bird Society but in order to reflect the diversity of our natural history interest, has now been renamed Beccles Wildlife Group. Several new volunteers have come along to help on the reserve and since joined the group.

Nest box surveys were carried out throughout the spring and early summer with some ringing of the chicks completed thanks to help from Adham from the British Trust for Ornithology.

It was perhaps surprising that the new woodcrete boxes were, percentage-wise, much more successful than the traditional wooden boxes, some of which were quite damp and, I guess, not so popular. Because of this and to save much time and effort in maintaining the wooden boxes, we would like to change all the blue and great tit boxes over to woodcrete boxes.

These come in at around £25 each thus we are seeking sponsors in order that we can carry this out. Have Covid-19 and Flu Vaccinations

Having your Covid-19 vaccinations is the best way to reduce the risk of being seriously ill and hospitalised. Get your first, second or booster jabs! The flu vaccination is the best protection to avoid catching and spreading flu. If you are eligible, please have the flu vaccination as soon as possible.



Wear a Mask

Covid-19 and flu viruses are airborne. Protect yourself and help prevent passing on Covid-19 or flu to to other people by wearing a mask in any busy or indoor public spaces. Remember you can still catch and pass on Covid-19 when you have NO symptoms and have been vaccinated.



Regular Testing

As many people have Covid-19 without any symptoms, take regular Lateral Flow Tests to check that you are ok and not accidentally passing on Covid-19 to other people.



Isolate and test when symptoms appear

The rule of thumb - if you are unwell stay home until you get better. It can be difficult to tell the difference between cold, flu and Covid-19 symptoms, so please take a Covid-19 PCR test to check. If this test result is positive, please follow the isolation guidance.



Ventilation

When indoors and mixing with people from different households, open windows and / or doors to keep the room well ventilated. This allows fresh air to circulate to reduce the number of any virus droplets that you could breathe in.




Hands and Space
