The total cost of a new replacement minibus is £55,000. Last week we had some good news that an application to the Lottery Fund has produced a grant of £19,800. Together with grants from Townlands, Bernard Sunley Trust, and some very generous donations, we now have a total of £43,000 towards the new minibus. Well within touching distance.
